At the end of pool play I need all of the pool scores in order to seed the playoff. The plate umpires will record scores on the schedule page at each field. The winner of the last pool game needs to phone me (799-9550) to report those scores.

All 28 teams go to the playoff. Seeding is as follows: We first use the seeding criteria (see the Rules) to order the teams 1, 2, 3 and 4 within each pool. (So A\#4 means the fourth-place team in the A pool after pool games are played.) In the first round of the playoff, the fourth-place teams in each pool move to a nearby field (as shown) to play the third-place team from that field's pool. (Example: the fourth-place team from the Armstrong 1 pool, F\#4, moves to Armstrong 2 to play the third-place team, G\#3, from the Armstrong 2 pool, and vice versa.) So the first round of the elimination is predetermined for the third and fourth place teams. We don't seed those teams. As soon as you know you are in third or fourth place in your pool, go to (or stay at) the correct field so you are ready to play at 2:30.

Next, we will use the seeding criteria again to order the first-place teams from the seven pools as seeds 1 through 7 and the seven second-place teams as seeds 8 through 14. In the second round of the playoff, the second-place teams play the winners from the first round. The third round matches the first-place teams with the winners from the second round. From there, it's standard single elimination. We reserve the right to bump the second-place teams' seeding numbers up or down by one spot to avoid repeat matchups in the playoff. We'll phone you with your seed.

Teams are asked to supply base umpires during the playoff as follows: For the 2:30 and 3:30 games, the team scheduled to play the next game on the field is responsible to supply a base umpire. (For example, seed 9 umpires the 2:30 game at Lights. Seed 5 umpires the 3:30 game at Armstrong 2.) For the 4:30 and 5:30 games, the loser of the previous game is asked to supply an umpire. The tournament will supply two umpires for each of the last three games.

Single elimination playoff


Profits from the tournament go to the Spanish Mennonite Council (missionary work in Latin America) and to the Lancaster Homeless Outreach Center. Each gets $\$ 800$. Additional profits will support a local food bank.
