Because of the smaller number of teams we have only two pools this year. You will play each of the other teams in your pool for your first three (or four) games. Each pool has its own field(s) (as shown) for the morning on Saturday.

We have three teams each from the Ephrata and Donegal leagues and only two pools for them. Consequently the A pool has two Donegal teams and two Ephrata teams. Those teams will play another team from your own league during pool play. Other than those matchups we have tried to ensure that the teams you face in pool play are teams that you do not play in your own league and have not been pooled with in recent years in our tournament.

Note for pool A teams: Each field has five game slots and a half-hour break mid-morning. Each team will play in four of the slots (two before the break and two after) and be off for one slot. In the game slot when you are not playing, your team will need to provide base umpires for both fields.

Winner of coin toss gets choice of home or away in pool games. Home team offers a prayer before the game.
The team in parentheses is responsible to supply a base umpire. The tourney supplies plate umpires for all games.

Tournament headquarters is at Armstrong 1. Could the winner of the last pool game at GovStable, please text or phone me (717-799-9550) with the scores from your pool.

All teams except for the lowest ranked team in pool A go to the single elimination playoff. Your place of entry into the playoff bracket is determined by your ranking within your pool. Use the seeding criteria from the Rules (Win-Loss record, then head-to-head, then run differential) to order the teams \#1, \#2, \#3 and \#4 (and \#5 in pool A) within your pool. (So A\#4 means the fourth-place team in the A pool after pool games are played.)

The entire playoff bracket is played on the two Armstrong fields. In the first round, the fourth-place teams play the third-place teams. As soon as you know you are in third or fourth place in your pool, go to the correct field so you are ready to play at 3:30.

In the second round of the playoff, the second-place pool teams play the winners from the first round as shown in the bracket. Second-place teams, as soon as you know you are \#2 in your pool, consult the bracket below to see which field you play on at 4:30. Send one of your players to that field to act as a base umpire for the 3:30 game.

The third round matches the first-place pool teams against the winners from the second round.
Teams are asked to supply base umpires during the playoff as follows: For the 3:30 and 4:30 games, the team scheduled to play the next game on the field is responsible to supply a base umpire. (For example, team A\#1 umpires the 4:30 game at Armstrong 1.) The tournament will supply two umpires for the last three games.
