We have two pools for the morning games. Since the B pool has only three teams, we created some crossover games with the A pool to ensure that each team has at least three pool games.

We tried to avoid repeat matchups from last year's pool play.

We usually try to arrange pool games so that you are not playing teams from your own league. This year that was not possible since four of the seven teams are from the Manheim league.

Winner of coin toss gets choice of home or away in pool games. Home team offers a prayer before the game.

The team in parentheses is responsible to supply a base umpire. The tournament supplies plate umpires for all games.



All teams go to the single elimination playoff. Your place of entry into the playoff bracket is determined by your ranking within your pool. Use the seeding criteria from the Rules as follows: 1. Win-Loss record (use percentages when comparing teams that have played different numbers of games) 2. head-to-head, 3. run differential. Order the teams #1, #2, #3 and #4 within your pool. (Example: in the elimination bracket below, team A#2 refers to the second-ranked team from the A pool and is not necessarily the same as team A2)

We start the playoff with the weaker teams and gradually feed in stronger teams. The team listed in parentheses is responsible to supply a base umpire. We will remind you. The tournament supplies two umpires for the last three games.

In all playoff games, the higher ranked team gets choice of home or away. When equally ranked teams play, use the coin toss.
