We have two pools for this year. You will play each of the other teams in your pool for your first three games. Each pool is on one of the Armstrong fields (as shown) for the morning on Saturday.

We have three teams from the Manheim league and only two pools for them. Two Manheim teams went into the B pool. Other than those teams, you will not face a team from your own league in pool play.

We also try to avoid putting you into a pool with teams that were in your pool last year. With four teams per pool and only two pools, it is not always possible to eliminate such rematches but we have tried to minimize them.

We tried to balance the strength of the teams in each pool based on your W-L record so far this year and your results in our tournament in past years.

Winner of coin toss gets choice of home or away in pool games. Home team offers a prayer before the game.

The team in parentheses is responsible to supply a base umpire. The tourney supplies plate umpires for all games.

All teams go to the single elimination playoff. Your place of entry into the playoff bracket is determined by your ranking within your pool. Use the seeding criteria from the Rules as follows: 1. Win-Loss record, 2. head-to-head, 3. run differential. Order the teams #1, #2, #3 and #4 within your pool. (Example: in the elimination bracket below, team A#2 refers to the second-ranked team from the A pool and is not necessarily the same as team A2)

We start the playoff with the weaker teams and gradually feed in stronger teams. The team listed in parentheses is responsible to supply a base umpire. The scheme is that you base umpire the game before your entry into the playoff. We will try to remind you. The tournament supplies two umpires for the last three games.

In all playoff games, the higher ranked team gets choice of home or away. When equally ranked teams play, use the coin toss.
