There is a one hour break (2pm—3pm) between the end of pool games and the start of the single elimination playoff. I need the scores from the pool games in order to seed the playoff. The plate umpires will be recording scores on the schedule page at each field. The winner of the last pool game is responsible to phone me (799-9550 cell) to report those scores. Or, you may deliver scores to me in person at the Lights field at Fuhrman park, Maytown.

All 28 teams go to the playoff. Seeding is as follows: We first use the seeding criteria (see the Rules) to order the teams 1, 2, 3 and 4 within each pool. Using the same criteria again, the first-place teams from each pool become seeds 1 through 7, the second-place teams get seeds 8 through 14, etc. We reserve the right to bump the third- and fourth-place teams' seeding numbers up or down by one spot to avoid repeat matchups in the playoff. I'll phone you with your seed.

In the first round of the playoff, each fourth-place team faces a third-place team. In the second round, the first-round winners face the second-place teams. The winners from that round face the first-place teams in the third round. From there we use standard single-elimination format, as shown in the bracket below.

Teams are asked to supply base umpires during the playoff as follows: For the 3:00 and 4:00 games the team scheduled to play the next game on the field is responsible to supply a base umpire. (For example, seed 11 umpires the 3:00 game at E-town. Seed 6 umpires the 4:00 game at Armstrong 2.) For the 5:00 and 6:00 games, the loser of the previous game is asked to supply an umpire. The tournament will supply two umpires for the 7:15 and 8:15 games.
