In the second round of the playoff, the second-place teams from each pool play the winners from the first round of the elimination. (However, unlike previous years, the slot at which those second-place teams enter the playoff is determined in advance as shown below rather than by a seeding procedure. This year, nobody will be waiting to find out where to play.) Second-place teams, go to your field immediately since you need to provide a base ump for the game before yours.

The third round matches the first-place pool teams with the winners from the second round. From there, it's standard single elimination. Preference for the paths that include a bye went to the teams that played in the championship game last year. (Of course, those teams need to win their pool to win the bye.)
